All band Members eligible to vote may nominate a Candidate at this time.

Eligibility for Candidates to be nominated, as set out in the *Kawacatoose First Nation Election Act*

- a. must be at least 18 years old and a member of the Kawacatoose First Nation
- b. must attest that he or she has not been convicted of an indictable offence on a date less than five years (5) years preceding the date of the Nomination Meeting
- c. must be properly nominated as a Candidate and must accept such nomination by written acceptance in Form F or Form G.
- d. If elected, the candidate will, within 60 days of his or her election, establish his or her ordinary residence on the Kawacatoose First Nation and maintain such residence through his or her entire term of office.
